Stanford Rivers Parish Council CCTV – Subject Data Request - request CCTV footage of yourself

You have the right to request CCTV footage of yourself.

You will need to make a request to the owner of the CCTV system (in this case Stanford Rivers Parish Council). You can do this either in writing or verbally.

You need to advise the Parish Council that you're requesting information held about you under data protection law. The Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) has guidance about getting copies of your personal data (www.ico.org.uk).

You will need to provide information to help the Parish Council identify you, for example:

- a specific date and time
- proof of your identity
- a description of yourself

The CCTV owner must usually provide the footage free of charge within 1 calendar month.

The CCTV footage is deleted approximately 21 days after it's recorded, however this can vary.

The CCTV owner might not be allowed to share any footage if:

- other people can be seen in it
- they're not able to edit out people to protect their identity

The CCTV owner can invite you to a viewing of the footage if:

- they're unable to provide you with the footage itself
- you agree to that arrangement

They can refuse your request if sharing the footage could put an ongoing criminal investigation at risk.
